Narrative Regarding Profit From Farm Use

The lands/parcels subject to this application have never been used for profit from farm use. The subject area has not had water rights and water rights are not available. The attached USDA/NRCS shows the soil classifications for the subject tract. The soil in the northerly part of the subject tract is listed as Map Unit 19B, known as McLoughlin silt loam, 2 to 5 percent slopes. Referring to page 15 of the report, when irrigated, this soil falls in the Class 3s land capability classification. When nonirrigated, this soils falls in the Class 6s land capability classification. Since there are no water rights on this tract and it has not been irrigation, the soil within the limits of the application are Class 6 soils.

Narrative About the Impact to the Accepted Farm or Forest Practices on Surrounding Lands Devoted to Farm or Forest Use

The surrounding area is dry range land and is predominately undeveloped and unirrigated lands. There are no abutting properties dedicated to farm or forest use. Abutting lands to the east are single family residential land use, and abutting lands to the north, south, and west are dry, unirrigated range lands.
