COURT MINUTES

Commissioner Jacobs moved to approve Court Minutes of August 6, 2025 as written. Commissioner Mendiola seconded and the motion passed unanimously.

FUNDING AGREEMENT – MCDC

Commissioner Jacobs moved to approve Agreement for Funding with Malheur County Development Corporation (MCDC) for executive director and professional services for the Treasure Valley Reload Center (TVRC). Commissioner Mendiola seconded and the motion passed unanimously. See instrument # 2025-2704

SUPPLEMENTAL BUDGET RESOLUTION

Commissioner Jacobs moved to approve Supplemental Budget Resolution R25-25: In the Matter of Fiscal Year 2025/2026 Supplemental Budget by Resolution Under Local Budget Law ORS 294.471. Commissioner Mendiola seconded and the motion passed unanimously. The purpose of the supplemental budget is to allocate Oregon Department of Veterans Administration (ODVA) hold-over funds in the CVSO (County Veterans Service Officer) Expansion Fund that were not anticipated when the budget was adopted; these funds will be used for advertising/promotions and travel/training. LIQUOR LICENSE APPLICATION

Commissioner Mendiola moved to recommend that the Oregon Liquor and Cannabis Commission (OLCC) liquor license application for LV Petroleum, LLC (Applicant)/TA Huntington (Trade Name) at 5945 US Hwy 30, Huntington for Off-Premises Sales be granted.
