MALHEUR COUNTY COURT MINUTES

January 17, 2018

County Court met with Judge Dan Joyce presiding with Commissioner Don Hodge and Commissioner Larry Wilson present. Staff present was Administrative Officer Lorinda DuBois.

Also present were members of the Ontario Chamber Leadership Group; and John Braese of the Malheur Enterprise.

LANDFILL UPDATE

Environmental Health Director Craig Geddes and Environmental Health Specialist Eric Evans met with the Court and provided an update on the Lytle Boulevard Landfill. The final tonnage numbers for the Landfill at the end of 2017 did not exceed the allowed limit; the final daily tonnage rate was 19.4753 per day (20 tons per day is the maximum allowed). An agreement was reached with Fox Sanitation and an annual disposal limit was set for 2018; this agreement allows for Fox Sanitation to manage their disposal loads at their discretion. The landfill is once again open to the public on Saturdays. The winter storm damaged special-permitted demolition waste trench closes February 1, 2018.

COURT MINUTES

DEMOLITION CONTRACT - CLARK IRRIGATION

CROSSING PERMITS

Commissioner Hodge moved to approve Crossing Permit No. 03-18 to WM. T. (Tom) and Sharon J. Dikeman to repair an irrigation pipeline on Redtop Road #960; and Permit No. 04-18 to Cascade Natural Gas to bore across Airport Road #888. Commissioner Wilson seconded and the motion passed unanimously. Original permits will be kept on file at the Road Department.

ONTARIO CHAMBER LEADERSHIP GROUP

The Ontario Chamber Leadership Group participants introduced themselves to the Court members. The Court members briefly gave an overview of their positions and answered questions from the Group participants.
