The regularly scheduled meeting of the County Court was called to order by Judge Dan Joyce at 9:00 a.m. in the County Court Office with Commissioner Ron Jacobs and Commissioner Jim Mendiola present. Members of the media, public and staff had the opportunity to join the meeting electronically or in-person. Notice of the meeting was posted on the County website, Courthouse bulletin board and emailed to the Argus Observer, Malheur Enterprise and those persons who have requested notice. TREASURE VALLEY PARAMEDICS (TVP) - QUARTERLY REPORT and EXTENSION OF AGREEMENT

TVP, Inc. President Steve Patterson, Vice-President Heather Land, and Attorney Shawn Logan met with the Court and provided a quarterly update per the terms of the personal services contract amendment. The use of the chase car continues to be successful; the chase car is not called out often and there is ALS (Advanced Life Support) in Nyssa. There has not been a reduction in services with the use of the chase car and TVP requested that the agreement for use of the chase car be extended. Some local paramedics are returning to employment with TVP; another local individual just completed her Oregon paramedic licensing; and TVCC (Treasure Valley Community College) has a program starting this Fall. Commissioner Mendiola moved to approve Second Amendment to Personal Services Contract for Emergency Medical and Ambulance Service, Ontario ASA (Ambulance Service Area) Malheur County Oregon with Treasure Valley Paramedics (TVP). Commissioner Jacobs seconded and the motion passed unanimously. The agreement expires July 1, 2027. See instrument # 2024-2219
