ALLOWS LICENSED MARIJUANA BUSINESSES IN MALHEUR COUNTY UNDER OREGON LAWS (10 words)

Question

Should County Code Title 3 Chapter 14 be repealed to allow marijuana businesses licensed by OLCC/OHA to operate in County? (20 words)

Summary

This measure repeals Malheur County Code Title 3 Chapter 14 in order to allow marijuana producers, processors, wholesalers, and retailers licensed by the Oregon Liquor Control Commission, and medical marijuana dispensaries regulated by the Oregon Health Authority, to exist in Malheur County pursuant to Oregon law. The measure does not apply within the boundaries/limits of any incorporated city within Malheur County (Ontario, Vale, Nyssa, Adrian, Jordan Valley). Malheur County would receive 3 percent local tax revenue from recreational marijuana sales, plus a portion of the 17 percent state tax revenue from recreational marijuana sales. (94 words)
