Order Prohibiting Outdoor Open Burning) Order
In Unincorporated Areas of Malheur County) GO-10-26
Located Outside of a Fire District)

WHEREAS, Section 2-1-5-2 of the Malheur County Code provides that the County Court may prohibit outdoor burning in the unincorporated area of the county located outside of a fire district; and


WHEREAS, the Malheur County Court finds that current circumstances of dry conditions, hot temperatures and record low fuel moisture, high winds, and rapidly changing fire conditions have created a severe public safety hazard to residents and visitors of Malheur County that can be exacerbated by outdoor burning.

NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS HEREBY ORDERED BY THE MALHEUR COUNTY COURT:

- 1. Outdoor burning, inclusive of burning in burn barrel, of all substances in the unincorporated areas of Malheur County located outside of a fire district is prohibited.
- 2. This Order is subject to the following allowable restricted outdoor burning:
 - a. Agricultural burns (for the planting or harvesting of agricultural crops), with restrictions (i.e. not over 90 degrees, not over 15MPH wind, water source on site, manned at all time during burn and extinguished at dusk)
 - b. Firefighter training.
 - c. Public utility, natural gas pipeline or mining operations.
 - d. Cooking food exclusively within a contained gas or charcoal grill.

3. A person who knowingly or intentionally violates this Order commits a violation pursuant to Malheur County Code, punishable by a fine up to \$200.
4. This order shall become effective on June 12, 2026 and shall remain in effect until specifically repealed in writing by the Malheur County Court.
