The Oregon Department of Transportation (ODOT) has been contacted with regard to a conditional use application for a proposed site Development to install a fueling canopy, dispensers, product piping and 15,000 gallon gasoline UST at 5987 US Highway 30, Huntington. This letter is to inform Malheur County Planning Department of the legal access status for the tax lot and any possible restrictions to the US-30 frontage.

ODOT has reviewed its records and determined that there are no access restrictions to the US-30 frontage of tax lot 900. The applicant will need to submit [An Application for State Highway Approach](#) for the proposed road connection to US-30. The road approach permit application is subject to review and compliance with approval criteria identified in Oregon Administrative Rule (OAR) 734-051 and I foresee no issues with the applicant being successful in obtaining a permit approval.
