Dear Mr. Evans:

The Oregon Department of Transportation (ODOT) was recently contacted by Jay Beebe requesting information regarding access to private property south of Adrian along OR-201S at approximate mile point 20.1.

It is my understanding that Mr. Beebe would like to place a new dwelling south of the highway between a road that I could not find a name for and Succor Creek Rd which is just east of the subject road. The road with no name is at a "Y" shaped intersection with OR-201S (aerial photo attached). I researched ODOT's files and found that the subject intersecting road is an abandoned portion of the State Highway under the jurisdiction of Malheur County (A&R 154).

This letter is to let Malheur County Planning know that ODOT does not have any issues or concerns with a new dwelling being placed on the southerly portion of tax lot 3400. If the Beebe's wish to access the highway directly rather than from the existing County Roads, they would need to apply for a new State Highway Approach Permit.
