

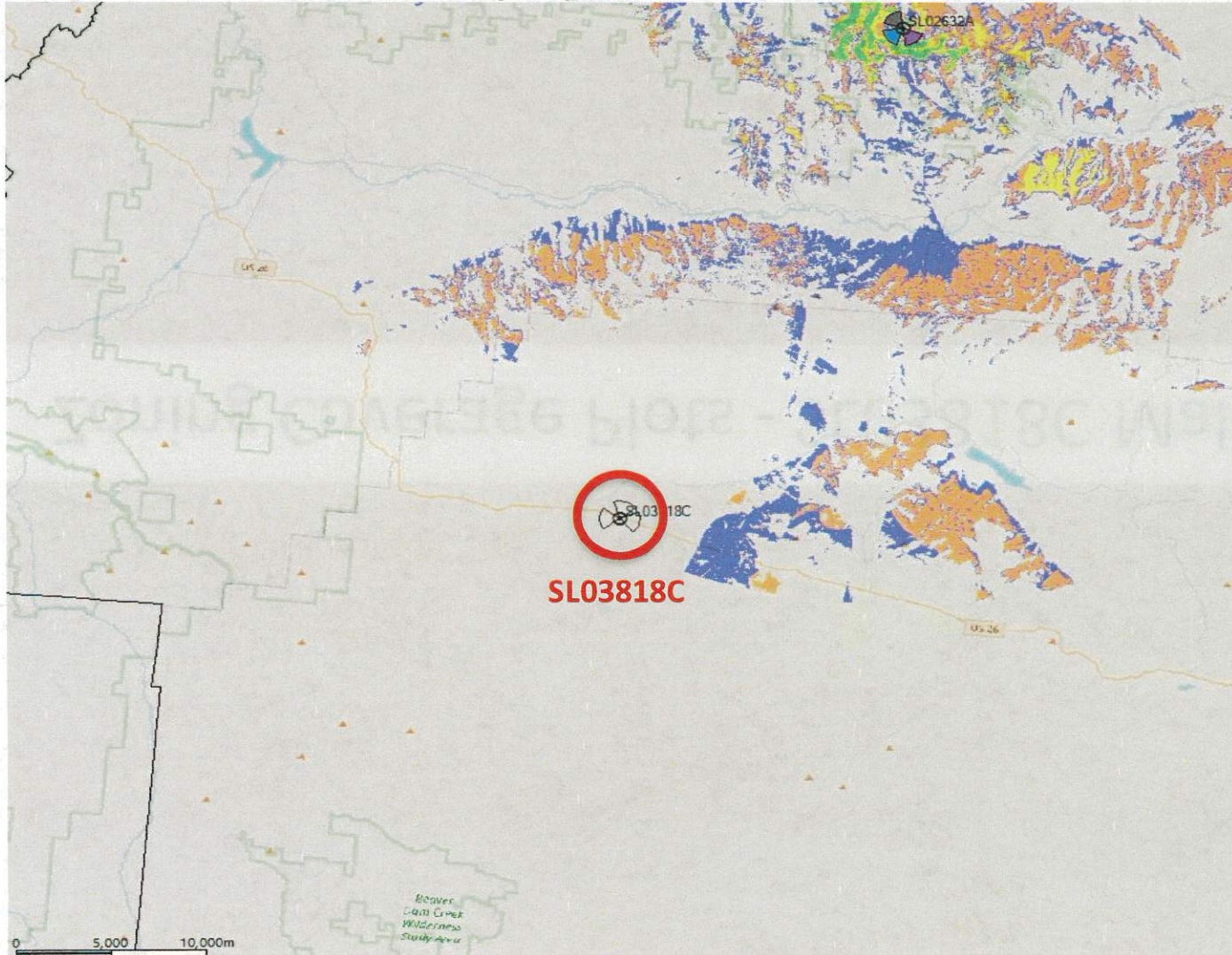

## Current coverage without proposed site SL03818C



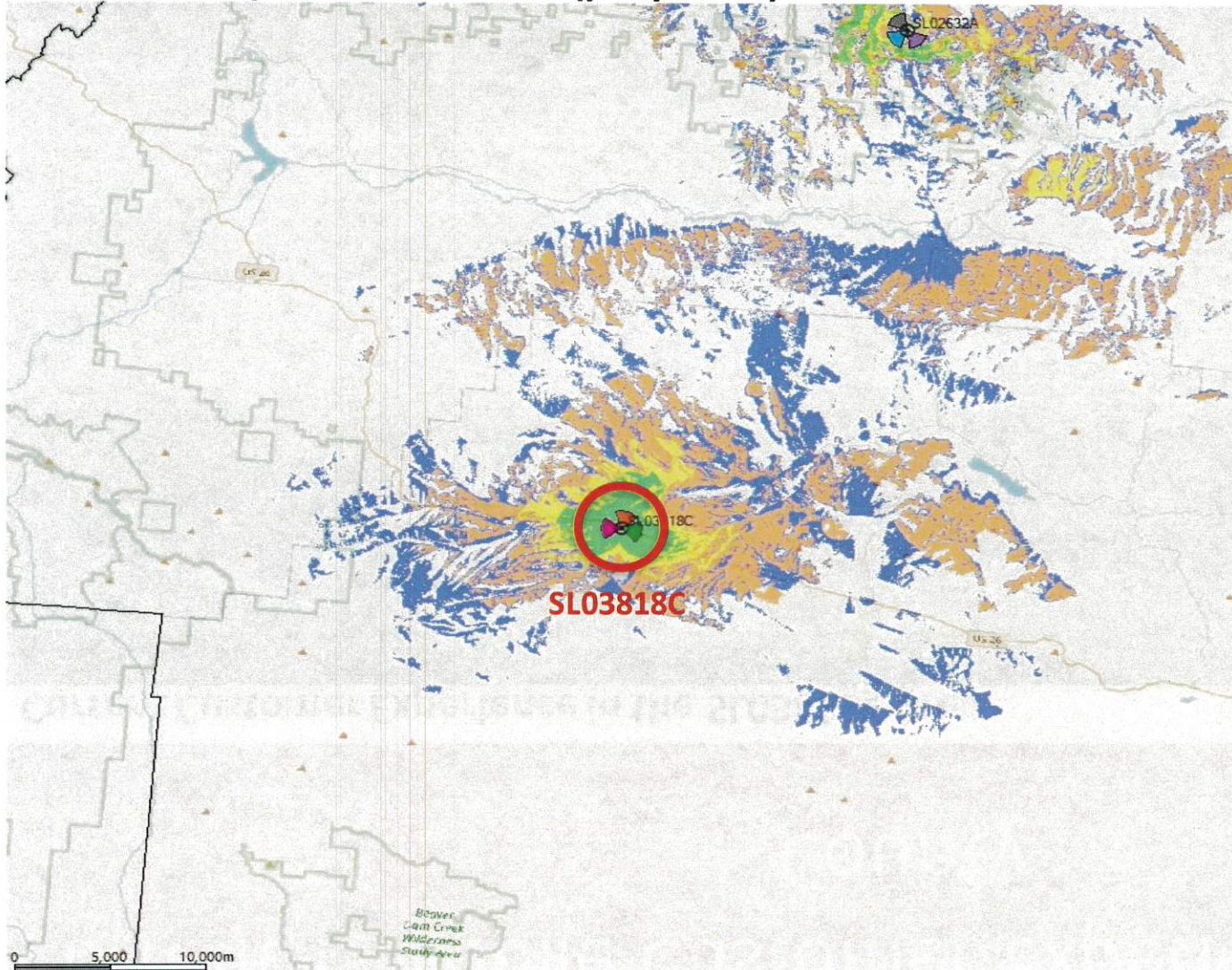

Based on the predicted coverage Map, after the site is brought on-air, customers will experience much improved signal levels along this section of Hwy 26 between Vale & John Day, OR.

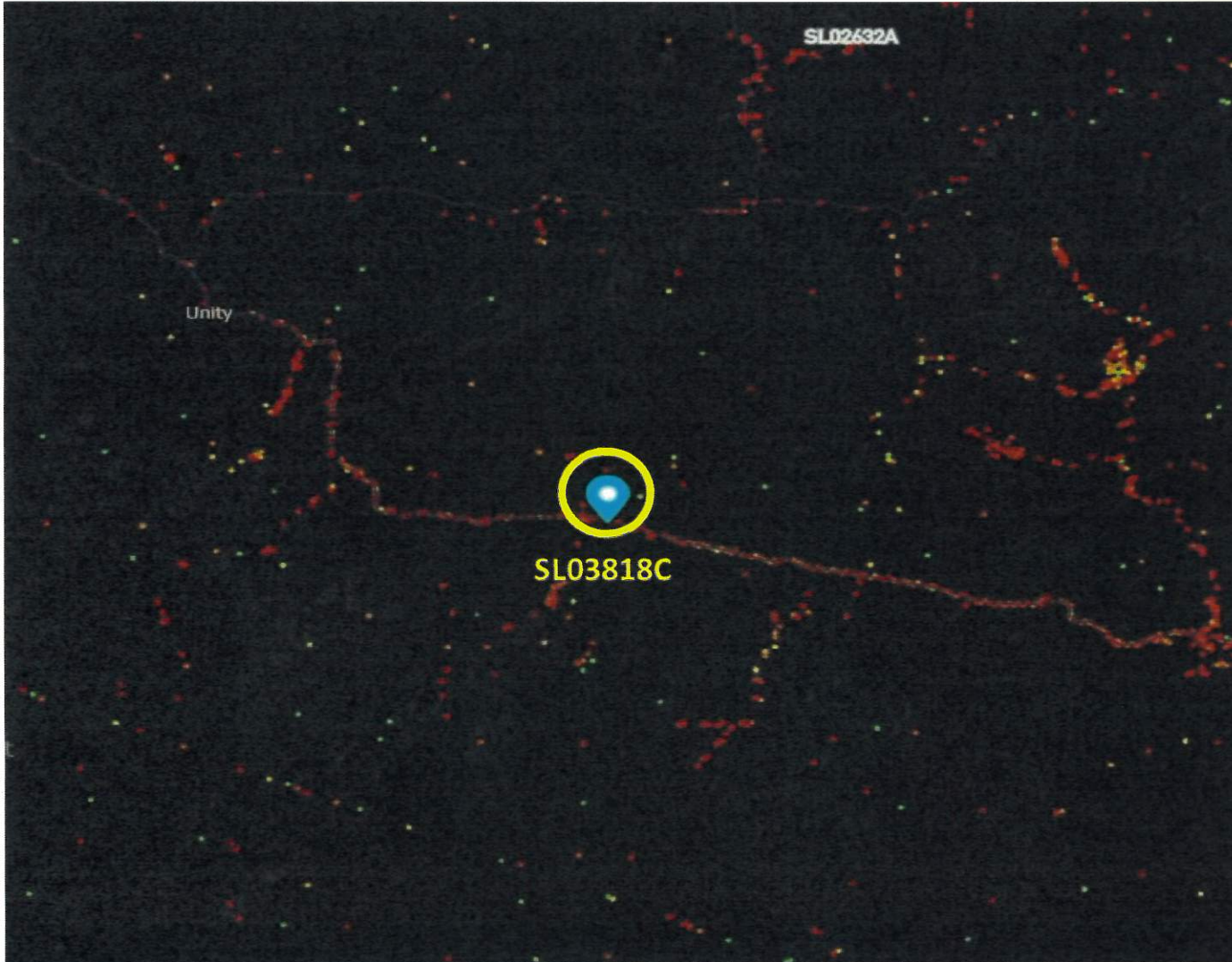
