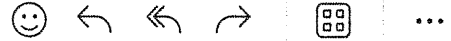

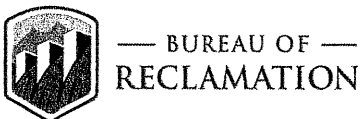
Thank you for reaching out.

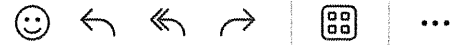
