Dear Calico Resources USA Corp. and Malheur County Planning Commission:

The Malheur County Road Department amends its correspondence of February 4, 2019 and provides the following standards for the access roads into the Grassy Mountain Mine Project.

Russell Road and Cow Hollow roads are rural minor collectors. The specifications illustrated in Appendix F, Drawing S-3 of the Malheur County Transportation System Plan, which was attached to our previous correspondence, depict an urban minor collector road.

Russell Road should be constructed to a 22' wide asphalt surface with 2' gravel shoulders.

Cow Hollow Road can be constructed to match the BLM specifications for Twin Springs Road.

As road improvements are designed and built, the County Road Supervisor and County Engineer may suggest more specific standards for certain sections of the roads.

Except for the above changes, all other terms and conditions of our correspondence dated February 4, 2019 remain relevant.
