

MALHEUR COUNTY COMPENSATION RATES

The following are the rates of the Malheur County Advisory Committee: Wolf Depredation Compensation and Financial Assistance Program for deaths attributable to wolf depredation based on fair market value:

Description	Lb/head	Rate
Calf still on the cow, heifer or steer	Will consider it to be a 600 pound steer	Monthly four week average (week of death or injury plus three previous weeks) from Producers Livestock Market Association, Vale.
Steer calf weaned	Will consider it to be a 875 pounder	Monthly four week average (week of death or injury plus three previous weeks) from Producers Livestock Market Association, Vale.
Heifer calf weaned	Use the 800 pound rate plus \$300/head	Monthly four week average (week of death or injury plus three previous weeks) from Producers Livestock Market Association, Vale
Open replacement weaned heifers	Use bred heifer rate	
Bred 2 to 5 year old cow	Use bred heifer rate	
Bred 6 to 8 year old cow	Use bred heifer rate minus \$150	
Ram, ewe, lamb, feeder sheep.		Consult Stan Brody from Idaho Wool Growers Association or Idaho Sheep Association
Mule, horse, llamas, working dog, swine, bison, alpacas, goat, domesticated fowl, ratites, jackasses, other		Based on a case-by-case basis taking into consideration factors such as use of animal, fair market value, less age and health determination deduction.

Compensation rates may vary depending on time of year of loss. Rates will be established using best information available as determined in the discretion of the committee.
